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*This is a “Travel like the locals” tour. The tours use public transport, i.e. regular buses, ferries and boats, but we have done the planning for you so that you can concentrate on enjoying your trip. You travel on your own - there is no guide or tour leader. On most of our tours you must change several times between different buses/ferries/boats, and it is up to you to make sure you catch your connections – truly travelling like a local! (The tours are set up so that the buses, ferries and boats connect.)*

## Round trip to Finnøy & Ona Lighthouse

Ålesund – Finnøy - Ona - Ålesund

This round trip takes you to Ona – a tiny island community out in the ocean. The trip starts in Ålesund by express boat to Harøya. Then you go by bus to Finnøya and on to Ona by ferry. The ferry stops at Sandøya before Ona. Passengers to Ona should stay on the ferry during the short stay at Sandøya.

Ona is Norway’s southernmost traditional fishing village and has a permanent population of approx. 25. The island also has a ceramics workshop and a small kiosk/shop. In the summer (typically June - August), there’s a café and possibilities for overnight stays.

On “Onakalven”, the island highest point, you find Ona lighthouse. From the lighthouse, you have a magnificent view of the ocean and towards the mainland.

Ona is a tranquil place where you can thoroughly enjoy the peace and quiet!

The trip to Ona is as fantastic in the summer as in the winter. Remember, though, that the island is located out in the ocean and the weather conditions can be harsh. Therefore, it is important to bring warm and windproof clothes.

If you go there outside of the peak season in the summer, we recommend bringing some food and drinks as well, as the island’s shop has a limited offering.

**Ålesund-Harøya:** You take express boat line no. 24 to “Nordøyane” from Ålesund express boat terminal at Skateflukaia. The boat stops at Hamnsund, Haramsøya and Fjørtofta on the way to Harøya. Please stay on board the boat during these stops.

**Harøya-Finnøya:** Bus 235 to Finnøya departs from the bus stop “Myklebust”, next to the express boat quay at Harøya. The bus goes to the ferry quay at Finnøya. The bus stop is called “Finnøya ferjekai”. This is the departure quay for the ferry to Ona.


**Finnøya-Ona:** At Finnøya ferry quay, you walk on board the ferry that takes you to Ona.

**Return trip:** The return trip follows the same route: from the ferry quay at Ona to the ferry quay at Finnøya, then bus 235 from the ferry quay at Finnøya to the express boat quay at Harøya, and express boat 24 from Harøya to Ålesund.
